New Year Wishes

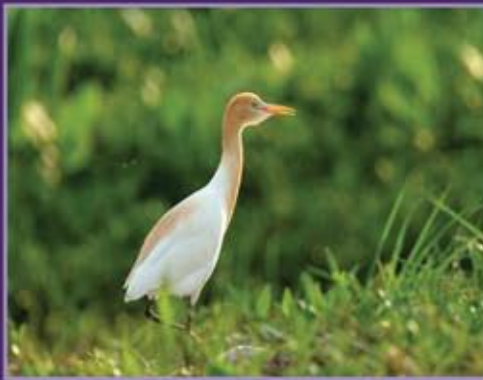
